- Supervise project timeline, identify critical path and key milestones for project's success
- Communication with stakeholders (client, utilities and authorities) having jurisdictions regarding interconnection, permitting, and other regulatory compliance issues
- Identify the sources of likely problems and proactively take preventive measures to avoid any potential project risks, and determine response actions to mitigate any negative impact
